"I want to fly across the sky!

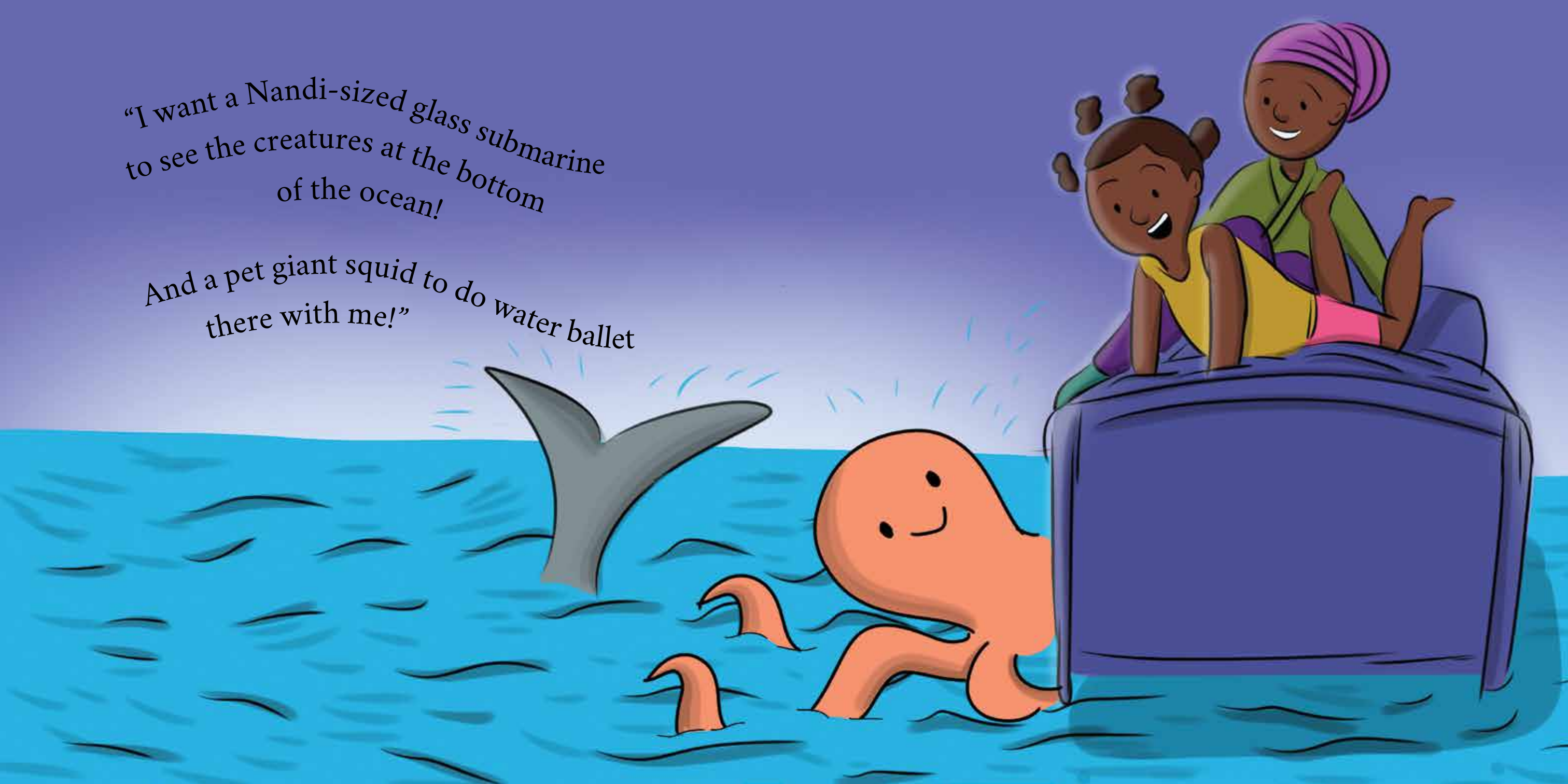
Leap from **star** to **star!**
